



New Driver Contract

It is understood and agreed that having a driver's license and driving a motor vehicle are privileges. Any privilege has to be earned and maintained on a continual basis. This means that driving privileges may be revoked at any time if you do not follow these rules:

1. Breaking the driving laws or abusing a motor vehicle can result in the loss of driving privileges, even if we learn about it from a source other than the police.
2. You will strive to maintain your grades, conduct and attitude at the same high level as when we first granted your driving privileges.
3. No one else should be allowed to drive any vehicle that has been entrusted to you. This means you may not lend your vehicle to your friends nor may you let someone else drive.
4. If you are ever in a frame of mind that could possibly render you less than 100% percent competent behind the wheel of a car, call us. This means you will *NEVER* drive after drinking alcohol or using any drugs. Call us and we will come get you. If you cannot reach us, hire a taxi. We will pay for it and this will not result in the loss of driving privileges.
5. You are never to be a passenger in a car in which the driver should not be driving. This means you will *NEVER* get into a car driven by anyone who has used any drugs or alcohol. Call us and we will come get you. If you cannot reach us, hire a taxi. We will pay for it and this will not result in the loss of driving privileges.
